Certain NSW egg businesses are required under legislation to hold a licence with the NSW Food Authority (the Authority) in order to run their food business.

Did you know ... if you are applying to licence a business and do not hold a current NSW Food Authority licence, you can now lodge your application online by going to the online application form link at www.foodauthority.nsw.gov.au (Please note: conditions apply for use of online applications).

Egg businesses that need to be licensed

The Egg Food Safety Scheme (under Food Regulation 2025) requires certain NSW egg businesses to be licensed. An egg business is one which undertakes any of the following activities (note: see definitions section on page 2 for more information):

- Producing, washing, grading, or dry cleaning more than 240 eggs in a week.
- The examination¹ of more than 240 eggs in a week to detect cracks (such as the final crack detection before sale eg candling).
- Manufacturing or processing of egg products (such as collecting pulp), blended egg product mixtures (such as scrambled egg mix, salted or sugared yolks).
- Pasteurising egg products and blended egg product mixtures.
- Storing egg products, blended egg product mixtures, cracked eggs.
- Transporting egg products, blended egg product mixtures or cracked eggs (if a business is conducting this activity, they will need
 to complete the application form Application for a licence for a food transport business for dairy/meat/plant products/seafood/egg
 and egg related products.

If you conduct any of the above activities without the appropriate licence, you are breaching the requirements of the Food Regulation 2025, hence the law.

Those producing less than 240 eggs for sale in any week do not need to apply for a licence. However, these businesses must notify their business details to the Authority at:

What do I need to comply with?

An egg business licensed with the Authority must comply with the *Food Act 2003*, Egg Food Safety Scheme (under the Food Regulation 2025) and the Food Standards Code.

A licensed egg business must also comply with any conditions specified on their licence. For example, certain egg businesses must develop and implement a food safety program that complies with Standard 3.2.1 – *Food Safety Programs* of the Food Standards Code (egg businesses solely producing eggs — not washing eggs, detecting cracks or collecting pulp and egg businesses storing or transporting are exempt from this requirement).

Under Schedule 8 of Food Regulation 2025, a business involved in the primary production of eggs must comply with the requirements for the control of Salmonella Enteritidis.

Guidance material to help egg businesses prepare their food safety program is available from the Authority's website at www.foodauthority.nsw.gov.au/industry/industry-sector-requirements/eggs.

What do I need to do next?

Complete this licence application form and return with payment (if applicable) to: NSW Food Authority, PO Box 232, Taree NSW 2430.

Note: licensed egg businesses that do not produce more than 1200 eggs for sale in a week are entitled to a licence fee waiver and a one-off licence application fee waiver. See payment information section on page 9 for more details).

- If you are starting a new business or buying a business from another person, you must apply for a licence before you begin operating. A licence is not transferable from one person or business to another.
- Effective from 26 November 2014, Standard 4.2.5 Primary Production and Processing Standard for Eggs and Egg Products in NSW, requires that all egg producers that perform crack detection, egg graders or egg processors in NSW to uniquely identify (stamp) individual eggs and/or packages of egg pulp for sale, to improve trace ability in the event of a food borne illness outbreak. Stamp details are to be supplied to the NSW Food Authority by egg businesses.
- Prior to the approval of a licence, a licensing assessment will be carried out to ensure compliance with the Food Standards Code
 and Food Regulation 2025. If the result of the assessment is unacceptable, the licence may not be approved and the licence
 application may be rejected. It is highly recommended the applicant refer to the Authority's website for information relating to the
 assessment process and industry sector requirements.

• **Please note:** This application does not allow you to stock your property. You must not commence any operations until the licence determination has been made and you are issued with a Food Authority licence. However, if you are submitting this application due to a change in ownership of an on-going business, or a change to your business, where the farm has previously been stocked with birds, prior to the licence application, NO eggs or poultry will be permitted for sale.

Processing times

The Authority will review your application within **10 working days** of receiving your licence application and you will be notified if any further information is required. If your application is complete the Authority will write to you to let you know your licence application has been processed and provide you with a time frame for completion of the licensing assessment that is required.

IMPORTANT NOTES

- If you have more than one premises, copy page 6 (for primary production activities) or page 7 (for storage/ processing
 activities) and complete for each premises. If the application forms are submitted at the same time only one application fee will
 be required.
- Please ensure that each page of the application is completed (where applicable) and checked before it is returned as failure to provide all information or signature(s) will delay processing and issuing of the licence.

DEFINITIONS

Blended egg product mixture means a product consisting of at least 80% by weight of egg white or egg yolk, or both, and other food.

Cracked egg means an egg with a cracked shell, where a crack is visible or visible by candling, and includes a broken egg.

Egg means the egg of any avian species, other than the egg of a ratite.

Egg business means a business involving any of the following:

- (a) Producing, washing, grading or dry cleaning more than 240 eggs in a week.
- (b) Examining more than 240 eggs in a week to detect cracks.
- (c) Manufacturing, pasteurising, or processing egg products or blended egg mixtures.
- (d) Transporting the following products or a combination of the products:
 - i. egg products (other than in dried form),
 - ii. blended egg product mixtures (other than in dried form),
 - iii. cracked eggs,
- (e) Storing the following products or a combination of the products on premises other than egg food production premises:
 - i. egg products (other than in dried form),
 - ii. blended egg mixtures (other than in dried form),
 - iii. cracked eggs, or any combination of those things, other than storing on premises in connection with a business that also undertakes any of the following on the premises:

Egg food production premises means premises in connection with a business that undertakes the following on the premises:

- (a) The manufacturing or processing of egg products or blended egg product mixtures,
- (b) The production of food using egg products or blended egg product mixtures, or both.

Egg product means the whole or part of the content of an egg with the shell removed and in any form.

Egg producer means a person who produces eggs for sale.

Full time equivalent food handler: any person who directly handles and/or supervises the handling of packaged or unpackaged food (includes eggs), food equipment and utensils, or food contact surfaces. It excludes office staff, cleaning staff, delivery drivers etc. The Food Regulation 2025 prescribes the appropriate licence fee (based on the number of people working on the premises) and the application fee to be applied to all licences. For licensing purposes only the number of full time equivalent (FTE) food handlers are counted. See page 9 for more information on how to calculate the number of full time equivalent (FTE) food handlers.

- Inspections & audits Egg producers will be routinely inspected by the Food Authority for compliance with requirements. Compliance or regulatory action will be taken if required. There may be fees for audits and inspections, payable by the licence holder after completion of the audit/ inspection.

CALCULATING LICENCE FEES

The licence fee applied to your business is calculated based on the number of full-time equivalent (FTE) food handlers involved in food handling. The number of FTE food handlers is used as it also accommodates businesses who use part time food handlers in their operations. For the purposes of this calculation, a FTE working week is 38 hours.

To calculate the number of FTE food handlers your business has, add up all the hours that the food handlers are undertaking food handling activities during a working week and divide by 38 hours (average working week). For example, if a facility had 4 food handlers to handle food for 25 hours per week, this would equate to approximately 3 FTE food handlers.

Figure 1: Example calculation of FTE food handlers

4 food handlers x 25 hours per week = 2.6 FTE food handlers (round up to 3 FTE food handlers)
